### NEW SKATER, BEGINNER, & ADULT C FREESTYLE EVENTS

These requirements are effective for the 2023/2024 competitive season. Previous years' placements are governed by the rules that were in effect for that specific skating season.

#### **Description Overview**

- New Skater events:
  - Created for the athletes who are new to skating
- Beginner events:
  - Created for the beginner athlete that is interested in pursuing more advanced competitions

#### **Event Qualifications**

- Skaters in these events will not have competed at Regionals in any event.
- A skater must move up after two wins (would move up during that season)
  - Or if the skater places twice in the season, the next season the skater must move up if there were 3 or more in the event
  - Or if a skater wins C or Bronze in the same discipline as a New Skater/ Beginner, and they place twice in C or Bronze– the skater must move out during that season
- Age breaks for all Beginner and New Skater events:
  - $\circ$  10 and under
  - o **11-17**
  - $\circ~$  18 and up
  - $\circ~$  It is up to the Meet Director to combine if there are less than 3 skaters per event

#### **New Skater Events**

- <u>Dance</u>: Forward strokes on the straight-a-way, corner steps to be determined by the draw
- <u>Freestyle</u>: Any combination of a bunny hop, forward spiral, or forward shoot-theduck on the straight-a-way; forward crossovers around the corner

#### **Beginner Events**

- <u>Dance</u>: The draw will consist of Glide Waltz, Progressive Tango, Academy Blues as determined by Meet Director.
- <u>Figures</u>: The draw will consist of 111A/B, 112A/B, and 1 as determined by Meet Director.
- <u>Freestyle</u>
  - A two-minute routine that consists of.
    - Bunny hop, Mohawk jump, ½ Mapes, single Mapes, Waltz jump, ½ flip
    - No single lutz, flips, loops or eulers(<u>There is a 10 point deduction for</u> <u>breaking this rule</u>). Skaters that can do these jumps should skate a "C" event.

- One two or three jump combo using any of the following jumps: Mohawk, BH, Waltz, ½ Flip or ½ Mapes, Kangaroo Jump, ½ jump (on two feet), or single (Mapes or Salchow).
- Spins that may be included: Two-foot spin, one-foot spin, IB upright, IF upright
- One sequence of footwork that may be included: Forward primary straight-line, forward primary diagonal, or backward straight-line
- <u>Creative</u>
  - 1:30min max
  - Maximum 1 jump (1/2 turn rotation)
  - Maximum 1 spin (upright)
  - Up to 1 section max of footwork (sequence down the long axis straight line pattern)
  - Footwork can include two-foot or one-foot turns
  - \* Skaters must only skate one creative event per contest
- Adult C Freestyle:
  - Same requirements as USARS C freestyle events, but the age group will be as listed below. If there are less than 3 skaters in the events, it is up to the Meet Director to combine.
    - 18-29
    - 30 and above
