NEW SKATER, BEGINNER, & ADULT C FREESTYLE EVENTS

These requirements are effective for the 2022/2023 competitive season. Previous years' placements are governed by the rules that were in effect for that specific skating season.

Description Overview

- New Skater events:
 - Created for the athletes who are new to skating
- Beginner events:
 - Created for the beginner athlete that is interested in pursuing more advanced competitions

Event Qualifications

- Skaters in these events will not have competed at Regionals
- A skater must move up after two wins (would move up during that season)
 - Or if the skater places twice in the season, the next season the skater must move up if there were 3 or more in the event
 - Or if a skater wins C or Bronze in the same discipline as a New Skater/ Beginner, and they place twice in C or Bronze

 the skater must move out during that season
- Age breaks for all Beginner and New Skater events:
 - o 8 and under
 - 0 9-12
 - 0 13-17
 - o 18-29
 - o 30 and above
 - It is up to the Meet Director to combine if there are less than 3 skaters per event

New Skater Events

- <u>Dance</u>: Forward strokes on the straight-a-way, corner steps to be determined by the draw
- Figures: Scooter pushes using 3 circles, two repetitions, may start on either foot
- <u>Freestyle</u>: Any combination of a bunny hop, forward spiral, or forward shoot-the-duck on the straight-a-way; forward crossovers around the corner
- <u>Creative</u>: Same as Beginner event requirements below, but can only do two-foot turns (no one-foot turns)

Beginner Events

- <u>Dance</u>: The draw will consist of the first two proficiency tests. (Glide Waltz, Progressive Tango, Academy Blues, Skater's March)
- Figures: The draw will consist of the first two proficiency tests. (111A/B, 112A/B)
- Loops: The draw will consist of (114A/B, 115 A/B)
- Freestyle
 - o A two-minute routine that consists of.
 - Bunny hop, Mohawk jump, ½ Mapes, single Mapes, Waltz jump, ½ flip
 - Jump combo that may be included: Bunny hop, waltz jump, Mapes
 - Spins that may be included: Two-foot spin, one-foot spin, IB upright, IF upright

 One sequence of footwork that may be included: Forward primary straight-line, forward primary diagonal, or backward straight-line

Creative

- Two age divisions: 17 y/o and below or 18 y/o and above
- 1:30min max
- Maximum 1 jump (1/2 turn rotation)
- Maximum 1 spin (upright)
- Up to 1 section max of footwork (sequence down the long axis straight line pattern)
- Footwork can include one-foot turns
- * Skaters must only skate one creative event per contest

Adult C Freestyle:

- Same requirements as USARS C freestyle events, but the age group will be as listed below. If there are less than 3 skaters in the events, it is up to the Meet Director to combine.
 - **18-29**
 - 30 and above
 - No move-up rule
